
Dear Mrs. Roosevelt:

come yesterday with my husband.

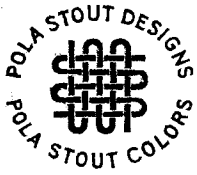

Dear Miss Thompson,

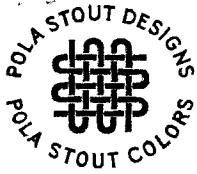
It was very good to meet you.
