For weeks the prize joke - on me - of the season has been bandied around the office, and perhaps it has reached your ears already. On the chance that it has not, I am forwarding the accompanying display.

We have a system of manuscript acceptance reports which, in the case of your books, is fairly academic. It has always been a gag here that Alan Green writes your catalogue description before the book is written; but at least he usually has a chance to talk to you about it before he does it. This year I thought I would go him one better by circulating the acceptance report before you had started writing the book. The result is enclosed.

This report in due course went to the production department, who failed to see through the gag and proceeded to turn it over to Bill English, the jacket artist. He promptly produced one of his masterpieces, also enclosed.

I wonder if you can't make good on this by giving us STIFF UPPER LIPSTICK for 1957.


